Earth Day – April 22

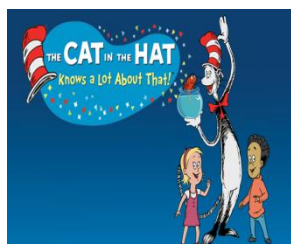
